

Exupery GIS – Installation Guide

Prerequisites

Java SE Runtime Environment

Currently we use the JRE 1.6 as our default environment.

You can download a appropriate version under <http://java.sun.com>

JavaEE Application Server - Apache Tomcat

Currently we use the Tomcat 6.0 as Application Server. In fact, every Application Server complaining the J2EE Standard can be used.

To install the Tomcat 6.0 just head to the Tomcat-Homepage. <http://tomcat.apache.org/>

If you use Tomcat on a Linux System you have to add the following Parameter to the tomcat.sh:

```
-Djava.awt.gadless=true
```

Deploying of Exupery-GIS

The Exupery-GIS consists of three Java – Web-Applications:

- geoserver
- exupery-flash
- exupery-symbolizer

Normally they come along as WARs (Web Application Archives) and will be exploded in Tomcat on startup if not already done. The three WARs have to be in the autodeploy-directory. Normally it is “webapps”.

Each Web-Application has a own context. It is set up by the web.xml where all the context-dependant variables reside.
